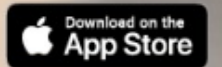

Other Environmental Initiatives

- CSL calls on Federal Gov't to make Monarch butterfly fields and federal lands north of PET Airport into urban park
- Examining pilot project to go to garbage collection every second week during winter season
- Subsidy for residents who replace a tree that is removed on their property
- Purchasing more electric vehicles

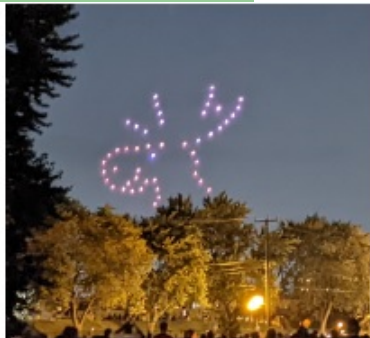
New / Updated By-Laws Coming

- Aiming to reduce water consumption
- Regulating noise from air conditioning, heat pump, pool equipment and other mechanical equipment
- SCAOPI / PPCMOI – related to non-conforming synagogues
- New master plan and zoning by-law revision

COVID Protocols

- Masks recommended but not required at Côte Saint-Luc municipal buildings, with some exceptions
- Masks will be required when attending City Council meetings or public consultations, or an event at the Harold Greenspon Auditorium.
- Return of most city services and programs
- vCOPs back on patrol as of March 2022

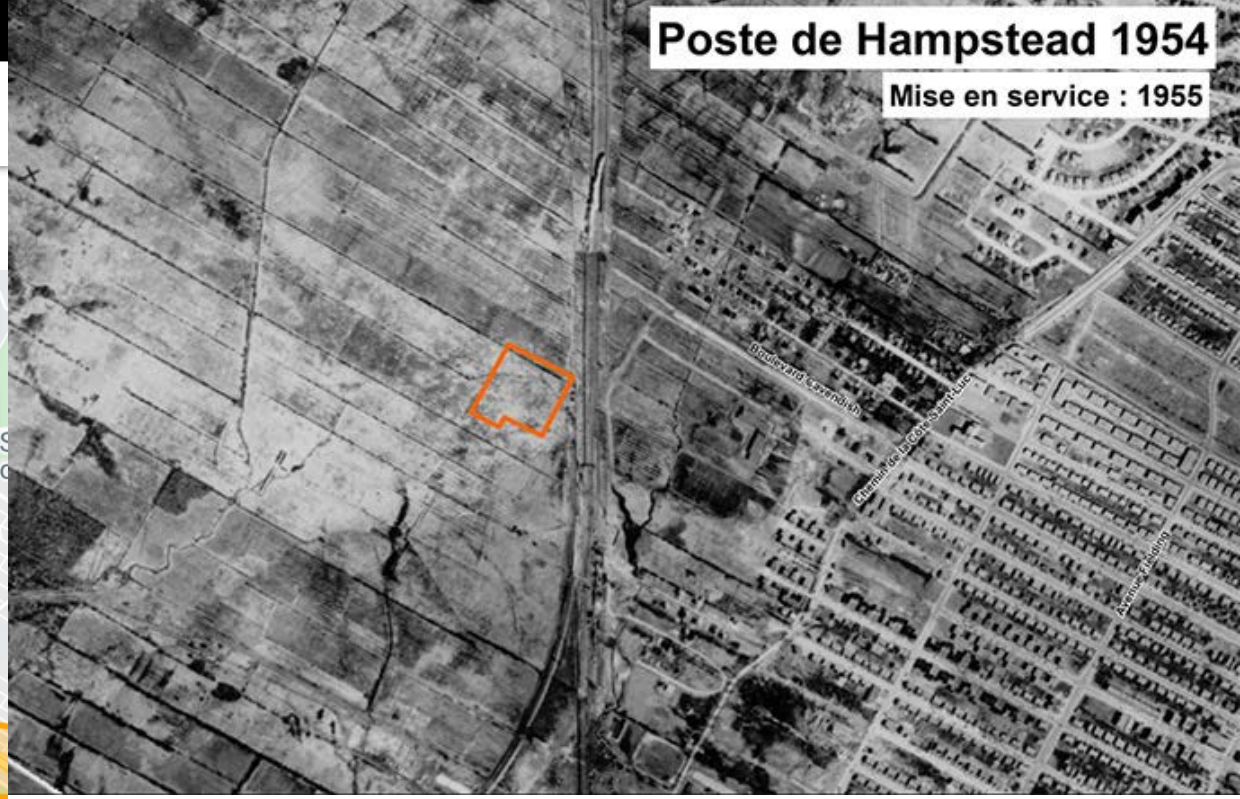

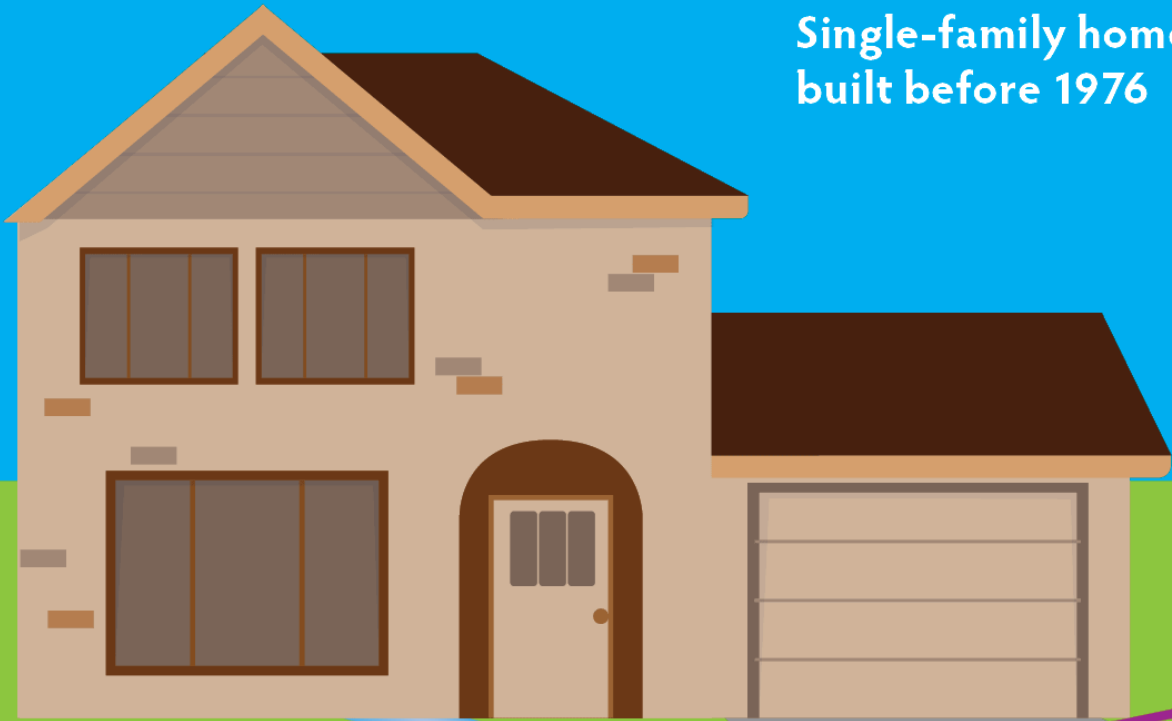

Water Testing

Water sampling program 2022

Between July 1 and September 30, 2022, the City of Côte Saint-Luc will be collecting water samples from single-family homes and duplexes built before 1976. Many homes built before 1976 have water service lines made of lead. To check whether your single-family home or duplex was built before 1976, verify the age on our database.

› **STEP 1: Verify the age of your home**

Water filter rebate program



Apply for \$50 rebate
